BACKGROUND

This amendment programs \$286,000 in Regional Improvement Program (RIP) funds for a project that could reduce the number of trips required to complete errands at various County establishments, by providing information on social and community based services from any one of the participating County establishments. This project proposes to improve efficiency, enhance mobility options and provide citizens access to necessary services, via internet technology, to local, regional and county level community service agencies. This project is a collaborative effort of City of Pomona departments working with community service agencies and technology professionals.
