BACKGROUND

This amendment programs \$139,000 in FY 2001-02 from Los Angeles County's Unprogrammed Share Balance towards a \$384,000 project to develop an internet web site to provide public transit information.

Currently there is an under utilization of transit by visitors to Los Angeles. This project will encourage the use of public transit at cultural tourism destinations by enhancing or creating web sites. Through web-based marketing, the project will encourage the use of mass transit at targeted trip generation nodes and facilitate transit use to regional destinations.
