RELINQUISHMENT RESOLUTIONS

The Department of Transportation recommends the California Transportation Commission approve Relinquishment Resolutions R-3524, R-3526, & R-3527.

All superseded highways included in the relinquishment resolutions summarized below are in a state of good repair. The local authorities have been advised of the pending relinquishments a minimum of 90 days prior to the Commission meeting for both superseded highways and collateral facilities pursuant to Section 73 of the Streets and Highways Code. Any exceptions or unusual circumstances are described by the individual summaries.

R-3524 – 6-Tul-198-PM R4.8/R8.8 (Request No. 84327) – 19 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the City of Visalia, between County Road 84 to State Route 63, Mooney Boulevard, consisting of reconstructed and relocated city streets, frontage roads, and cul-de-sacs. The City by cooperative agreement, dated December 16, 2001, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

R-3526 – 8-Riv-79-PM 29.9/30.9 (Request No. 419R) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the City of San Jacinto, between Record Road and Ramona Expressway, consisting of highway right of way superseded by transfer of highway location. The City by cooperative agreement, dated June 6, 2002, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

R-3527 – 8-Riv-79-PM 30.5/33.4 (Request No. 418R) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the County of Riverside, between the northerly city limit of the City of San Jacinto, near Quandt Ranch Road, to 0.3 mile east of Sanderson Avenue, consisting of highway right of way superseded by transfer of highway location. The County by cooperative agreement, dated April 16, 2002, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.
