RECOMMENDATION:

The California Department of Transportation recommends the California Transportation Commission approve the following resolution, allocating \$190,000 for the Eureka Waterfront Trail Phase A (PPNO 2069) Eureka Non-Freeway Alternative Program Project in Humboldt County.
