Dear Ms. Kiser and Mr. Sukys:

With this letter, I am transmitting Administrative Modification No. 11 to California's 2008/09-2011/12 Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP), which makes minor modifications to the FSTIP. Modifications are made to the following projects:

- SH_BRPRES – State Highway Operations and Protection Program (SHOPP), Bridge Preservation. The American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (Recovery Act) funds have been reduced in Fiscal Year (FY) 2008/09 by \$23,000 for project EA 38050, Mendocino County. The actual obligation amount was less than the programmed amount.
- SH_RDWAYP – SHOPP Roadway Preservation. The Recovery Act funds in FY 2008/09 have been increased by a net of \$1,325,000 for projects EA 2C50U and 1E030.
- BIKEPED – Bicycle Pedestrian Facilities grouped project listing for nonattainment areas. Recovery Act Transportation Enhancement funds are added to this project and Recovery Act Regional Surface Transportation Program funds are reduced. The total project cost has increased by \$21,000 in FY 2008/09.


These changes are submitted as an administrative modification. The changes are within the quadrennial element; do not reflect a change in the design concept or scope of the project, or impact financial constraints. Funding is available for these modifications.
