Dear Ms. Kiser and Mr. Sukys:

With this letter, I am transmitting Administrative Modification No. 35 to California's 2008/09-2011/12 Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP), which makes minor modifications to the rural, non-MPO portion of the FSTIP.

- Modifies funding for Tuolumne County J-59 High Priority Program (HPP) project. The total project cost has been increased by \$190,000 to reflect local agency funding of preliminary engineering and right of way and to account for the available HPP funds in Fiscal Year (FY) 2008/09.
- Modify funding for the Amador County Signage project funded with American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA) funds and grouped project listing RRRTBL2. Bids for the Signage project came in \$152,000 lower than the initial programmed amount. The savings from this project will be applied to the grouped project listing MPO ID Number RRRTBL2 – Pavement Rehabilitation and Intersection Improvements, non attainment counties, for use on the Latrobe Road, Amador County location.
- Modify funding for the grouped project listing PREVMaint and Glenn County Sixth Street Resurfacing. ARRA savings of \$181,129 from the Glenn County Sixth Street Resurfacing project, PPNO 1313, will be applied to a new location on Tehama Street in the PREVMaint grouped project listing.

These changes are submitted as an administrative modification. The changes are within the quadrennial element; do not reflect a change in the design concept or scope of the project, or impact financial constraints. Funding is available for these modifications. In

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addition, there are no projects in this Administrative Modification No. 35 that are included in any other amendment that is currently open for public review.

Since administrative modifications do not require Federal Highway Administration and/or Federal Transit Administration approval, this FSTIP modification has been amended into California's 2008/09-2011/12 FSTIP.
