SUBJECT: AMBAG MPO 2010/11 FTIP/FSTIP AMENDMENT NO. 7

We have completed our review of Amendment No. 7 to the Association of Monterey Bay Area Governments' (AMBAG) 2010/11 Metropolitan Transportation Improvement Program (MTIP) that was submitted by your letter dated August 12, 2011. This amendment, adopted by the AMBAG Board by Resolution No. 2011-13 on August 10, 2011, modifies the project listing for five projects and adds one new project listing to the 2010 MTIP and California's Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP).

Pursuant to the July 15, 2004, *Memorandum of Understanding between the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), California Division, and the Federal Transit Administration (FTA), Region IX*, we accept the proposed modifications to the 2010/11 FSTIP for the AMBAG Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) region in accordance with the Final Rule on Statewide and Metropolitan Transportation Planning that was published in the February 14, 2007, Federal Register. We find that the AMBAG MPO's 2010/11 MTIP, through Amendment No. 7, was developed through a continuing, cooperative and comprehensive transportation planning process carried out in accord with the metropolitan planning provisions of 23 U.S.C. 134, and 49 U.S.C. Chapter 53 as amended by Section 6001 of Public Law 109-59, the *Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient Transportation Equity Act: A Legacy for Users* (SAFETEA-LU).

The changes proposed to the Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP) by this MTIP Amendment is for projects listed in an area of the State of California that is designated as attainment or unclassified for Federal air quality standards, and as a consequence, is not subject to the requirement that an air quality conformity determination be made.

This letter also constitutes approval of the amendment with the understanding that FTA funding approval on individual projects is subject to the grantees meeting the necessary administrative requirements. If you have questions or need additional information concerning our approval of
