
With this letter, I am transmitting Administrative Modification No. 3 to California's 2010/11-2013/14 Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP), which makes modifications to the rural, non-Metropolitan Planning Organization portion of the 2011 FSTIP. These changes are consistent with the FSTIP Amendment and Administrative Modification Procedures. In addition, there are no projects in this administrative modification that are included in any other amendment that is currently open for public review.

- This administrative modification modifies funding for various grouped project listings. Projects included in this administrative modification are funded from the State Highway Operation and Protection Program, Highway Safety Improvement Program, and the Highway Maintenance Program.

Since administrative modifications do not require Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and/or Federal Transit Administration (FTA) approval, these changes have been incorporated into California's 2011 FSTIP.
