Dear Ms. Kiser and Mr. Sukys:

With this letter, the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) transmits Administrative Modification No. 17 to the California 2010-2014 Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP) which makes minor modification to the Rural non-Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) portion of the FSTIP. The changes to the existing projects include:

- Grouped Projects for FTA 5311 Operating Expense – Adds one project located in Humboldt County for \$377,000.
- Grouped Projects for Bike/Pedestrian Facilities for Attainment Areas – Adds one project in Humboldt County funded from State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) - Transportation Enhancement for \$120,000.
- Grouped Projects for State Highway Operation and Protection Program (SHOPP) Bridge Rehabilitation and Reconstruction Program – Modifies funding of a project in the grouped project listing totaling \$2.438 million.
- Grouped Projects for SHOPP Collision Reduction Program – Adds new projects and modifies funding of various projects in the grouped project listing totaling \$851,000.
- Grouped Projects for SHOPP Emergency Response Program – Adds new projects and modifies funding of various projects in the grouped project listing totaling \$1.886 million.
- Grouped Project Listing for Activities not leading to Construction – Federally Mandated Bridge Inspection Program – Modifies delivery of grouped projects from FY 12/13 to FY 15/16.
- Grouped Project Listing for Planning Activities – Develop Scour Plans of Action – Modifies funding totaling a reduction of \$244,000.
- Sunland Drive Overlay – Modifies project description to include wording “toll credits as match”.

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- McCann Ferry Improvement Project – Modifies funding of project components.
- Highway Bridge Program Projects (BR#26C0042, BR#3C0048, BR#17C0030) – Modifies delivery schedule and corrects programming error in CTIPS.
- Highway Bridge Program Projects (BR #32C0044, BR#32C0066, BR#32C0037, BR#32C0016, BR#26C0004, BR#26C0035, BR#30C0084, BR#30C0062, BR#30C0065, BR#30C0050, BR#17C0084) – These projects are included for information purposes only. Right of Way and Construction components were originally scheduled in beyond years. Modifies the delivery years further in the beyond years to match the latest Highway Bridge Program project listing.

This administrative modification adds new programming capacity of approximately \$5.4 million to the current financial plan that relies on the State's federal programming capacity. Our next rural non-MPO formal amendment will update the financial plan to reflect the actual funding to support the added programming capacity. These changes are consistent with the FSTIP Amendment and Administrative Modification Procedures and have no impact on the rural non-MPO financial constraint or air quality conformity. In addition, there are no projects in this administrative modification that are included in any other amendment that is currently open for public review.

Since administrative modifications do not require Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and/or Federal Transit Administration (FTA) approval, these changes have been incorporated into California's 2011 FSTIP.
