Dear Ms. Kiser and Mr. Sukys:

With this letter, the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) transmits Administrative Modification No. 19 to the California 2010-2014 Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP) which makes minor modification to the Rural non-Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) portion of the FSTIP. The changes include:

- Grouped Projects for State Highway Operation and Protection Program (SHOPP) Bridge Rehabilitation and Reconstruction Program – Adds two new projects and modifies funding of various projects in the grouped project listing totaling \$1.6 million net reduction.
- Grouped Projects for SHOPP Collision Reduction Program – Adds new projects and modifies funding of various projects in the grouped project listing totaling \$9.9 million.
- Grouped Projects for SHOPP Emergency Response Program – Adds new projects and modifies funding of various projects in the grouped project listing totaling \$1.5 million net reduction.
- Grouped Project Listing for Local Bridge Rehabilitation and Reconstruction – Non-Capacity increasing – Modifies funding and updates the grouped project listing.
- Highway Bridge Program Projects (BR#48C0032) – Moves already programmed project from the grouped project listing to stand alone project.
- Ridge Road Rehabilitation – Transfers funding from Right of Way to Preliminary Engineering. No change in scope or total project cost.

These changes are consistent with the FSTIP Amendment and Administrative Modification Procedures and have no impact on the rural non-MPO financial constraint or air quality conformity. In addition, there are no projects in this administrative modification that are included in any other amendment that is currently open for public review.
