Dear Mr. Hannon and Mr. Sukys:

With this letter, the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) transmits Administrative Modification No. 26 to the California 2010/11-2013/14 Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP) which makes minor modification to the Rural non-Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) portion of the FSTIP. The changes to the existing projects include:

- Grouped Projects for Safety Improvements – State Highway Operation and Protection Program (SHOPP) Collision Reduction – Modifies funding and adds one project to the grouped project listing totaling \$996,000;
- Grouped Projects for Emergency Response – SHOPP Emergency Response Program – Modifies funding and adds one project to the grouped project listing totaling \$5.6million;
- Grouped Projects for Bike/Pedestrian Facilities for Non-Attainment Areas – Modifies funding and adds two new projects in Nevada County totaling \$152,000;
- Dorsey Drive Interchange Project – Modifies the funding between fund sources without change in scope and total project cost.

This administrative modification adds new programming capacity of approximately \$6.7million to the current financial plan that relies on the State's federal programming capacity. Our next rural non-MPO formal amendment will update the financial plan to reflect the actual funding to support the added programming capacity.

These changes are consistent with the FSTIP Amendment and Administrative Modification Procedures and have no impact on the rural non-MPO financial constraint or air quality

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conformity. In addition, there are no projects in this administrative modification that are included in any other amendment that is currently open for public review.

Since administrative modifications do not require Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and/or Federal Transit Administration (FTA) approval, these changes have been incorporated into California's 2011 FSTIP.
