Please accept Administrative Modification No. 8 to the rural non-Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) portion of the 2011 Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP). These changes are consistent with the FSTIP Amendment and Administrative Modification Procedures.
